HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES DEFINITIONS

A.

A substance or combination of substances which, because of its quantity, concentration or physical, chemical or infectious characteristics, may:

- (1) Cause or significantly contribute to an increase in mortality or an increase in serious irreversible or incapacitating reversible illness; or
- (2) Pose a substantial present or potential hazard to human health or the environment when improperly treated, stored, transported or disposed of or otherwise managed.

B.

"Hazardous substances" shall also mean all substances defined under N.J.A.C. 7:1E-1.3 and listed in N.J.A.C. 7:1E Appendix A, titled "List of Hazardous Substances," promulgated April 28, 1982, by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, a copy of which is on file with the Township Clerk and which is incorporated herein by reference.

C.

"Hazardous substances" shall also mean:

- (1) Petroleum and petroleum products.
- (2) All pesticides designated as "prohibited," "restricted" or "specifically restricted" pursuant to the New Jersey Pesticide Control Act of 1971 (N.J.S.A. 13:1F-1 et seq.) at N.J.A.C. 7:30-1.5 through 7:30-1.7.
- (3) Substances designated as hazardous substances by the Federal Environmental Protection Agency pursuant to Section 311(b)2(A) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, Amendments of 1972, as amended by the Clean Water Act of 1977, 33 U.S.C. § 1321.
- (4) Substances designated as toxic pollutants by Congress for the Environmental Protection Agency, pursuant to Section 307 of the Federal Pollution Act, Amendments of 1972, as amended by the Clean Water Act of 1977, 33 U.S.C. § 1317.
- (5) Any other substances listed in Appendix A.
- (6) Any substance defined as a hazardous substance in Section 101(14) of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA), 42 U.S.C. § 9601(14), and hazardous wastes as defined in Section 1004(5) of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976 (RCRA), 42 U.S.C. § 6903(5), and as identified by the United States Environmental Protection Agency pursuant to Section 3001 of RCRA.
