



HOWELL TOWNSHIP CURBSIDE RECYCLING COLLECTION

The following recyclables will be collected curbside:

Aluminum and tin cans
(For example: soda, coffee, tuna fish)

Plastic #1 and #2 pourable bottles
(For example: milk, water, juice, soda, bleach, laundry detergent, shampoo, conditioner)

Newspapers, glass jars and bottles, flattened corrugated cardboard

Mixed Paper (For example: various recyclable paper including, but not limited to, printer paper, construction paper, junk mail, magazines, soft cover books)

- ⇒ Recyclables should be commingled in the same container. Excessive cardboard and newspaper may be tied with string and placed next to container.
- ⇒ Lids may be placed on recycling container.
- ⇒ Containers must have a hole drilled in the bottom as to allow water to drain.
- ⇒ A decal must be placed on the container. Call the Department of Public Works to have one mailed to your residence.
- ⇒ Curbside Recycling is picked up **every other** week.
- ⇒ If your collection day falls on one of the following **holidays** your recycling will be picked up on the **following Saturday**:

New Year's Day
Independence Day
Thanksgiving Day

Memorial Day
Labor Day
Christmas Day

NO recyclables will be accepted wrapped in **plastic bags** or **tape**.

RECYCLABLES MUST BE PLACED AT THE CURB THE NIGHT BEFORE.
PLEASE PLACE CONTAINERS WHERE VISIBLE TO DRIVERS
