



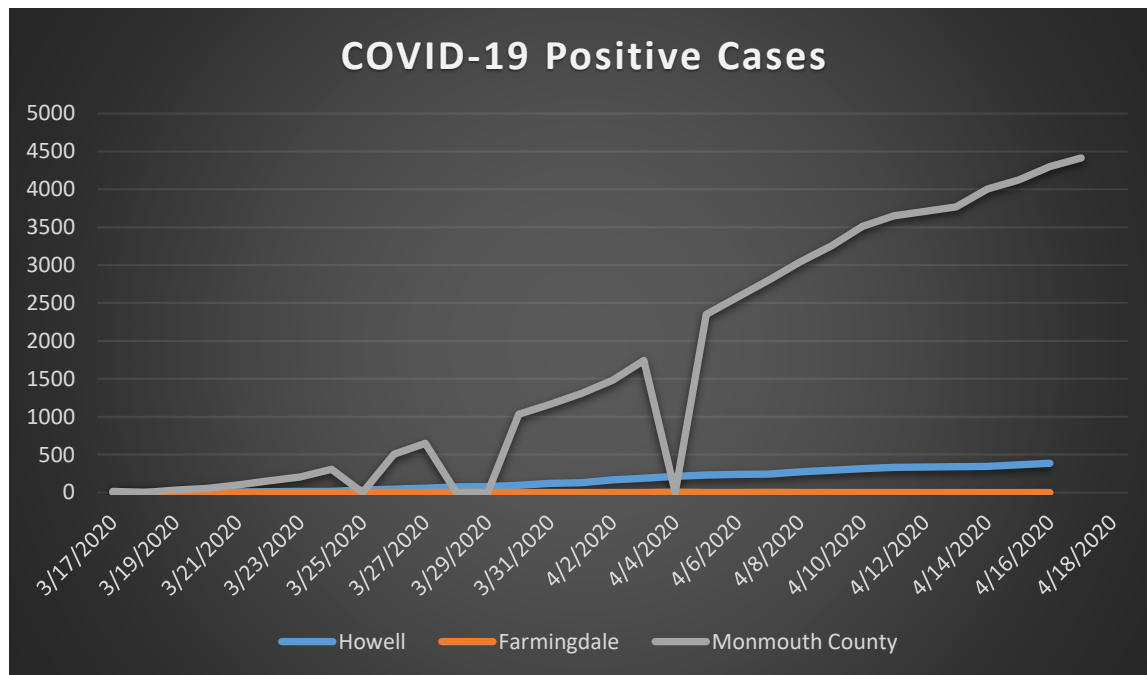

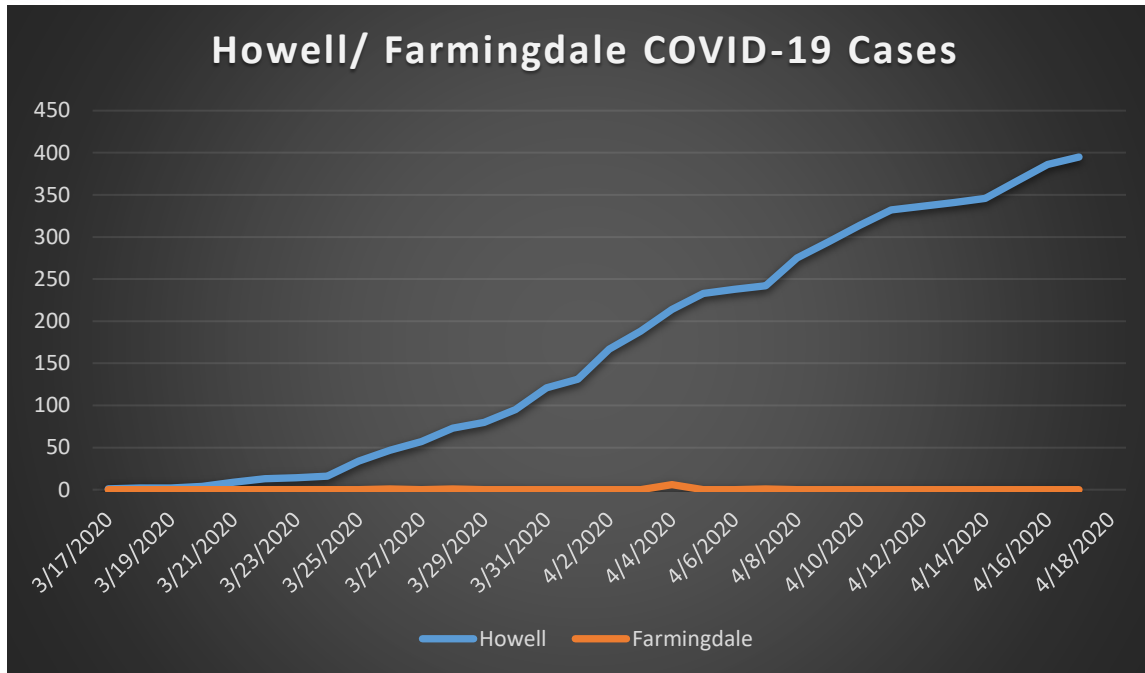

Howell Township has **395** Confirmed cases. Farmingdale Borough has **9** confirmed cases since the first positive case was reported on March 17, 2020. That is about 0.70% of Residents that have tested positive for the COVID-19.
