Update concerning Tropical Storm Isaias Recovery

Howell Office of Emergency Management continues to assist residents who are still impacted by Tropical Storm Isaias.

We are currently working with JCP&L to restore resident's power as soon as possible. There is currently 13,182 customers which is 62% of the Township without power. Crews are arriving from out of State to assist with this task of restoring power. The following actions were implemented by the Township.

- Cooling Centers have been open from 8:30am until 4:30pm at the following locations
 - Town Hall 4567 Route 9 2nd floor meeting room
 - Ardena Baptist Church 593 Adelpia Road
 - For seniors, the Senior Center is open. You must provide your own transportation.
- Mobile Charging stations have been located at Town Hall and Ardena Baptist Church. Hours of operation will be 8:30am to 4:30pm.
- Potable Water is available at the following locations:
 - Town Hall rear of the building
 - Adelpia Fire House
 - Squankum Fire House
- Ice and Water are available at the following locations
 - Shoprite 4594 Route 9, Howell
 - Shoprite 3585 Route 9, Freehold, NJ
 - Acme 3241 Route 9 @ Adelpia Rd, Freehold

Residents are encouraged stay away from downed power lines and trees, and do not drive through the barricades and cones that have placed at intersections.
