Re: Closing of all Township Parks

As part of our local declared State of Emergency, The Township is closing all of the Township Parks effective immediately.

This is due to the recent uptick in COVID cases combined with the large number of complaints being received that the parks are filled to capacity, with users not social distancing and with most individuals not adhering to the Executive Order 107 and not wearing mask.

Any individual not adhering to this closing, could face a fine under the local state of Emergency and Executive order 107.
